Nancy Tapken, South Dakota FBLA (Future Business Leaders of America) State Advisor has a critical need for volunteers for an upcoming FBLA event in Pierre. She is looking for volunteers to offer their time and expertise as a judge, or volunteers to help with check-in, as time keepers, to tabulate results, facilitate workshops and pre-judge events, at the FBLA State Leadership Conference on Monday, April 6, at the Pierre Ramkota. The state conference will bring 450 high school students from 23 schools across South Dakota to Pierre, to compete and showcase their business, career and leadership skills by presenting in a variety of business-related events. These dedicated students depend on professionals with experience in finance, marketing, entrepreneurship, hospitality, management and more, to offer constructive feedback that will inspire them to improve and potentially compete at the national level. For pre-judged events, students will submit videos via email or an online link. Pre-judged events/videos are emailed to judges by March 8. Judges have a two week window to judge entries at their convenience, from the comfort of their home or office, and return results to her by March 22. Judges on Monday, April 6, for the in-person events will be needed from 8:00-5:00. Judges can commit to an entire day, or half a day. You may judge more than one event/category, but the goal is to have you judge categories within your area of expertise. Judges/volunteers, will receive lunch, and snacks, as well as the satisfaction of knowing you have helped a student grow in confidence and skill! Judges will complete a scoring sheet for each competitor, including constructive feedback, which determines a student's placement in that competition category.
